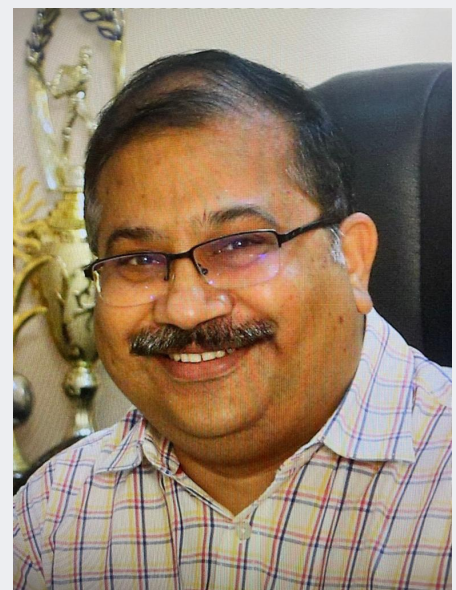

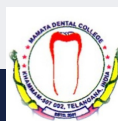

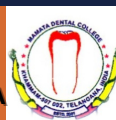

WORKSHOP ON RESEARCH METHODOLOGY- 2021

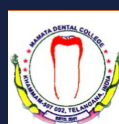
